Applications are on line. Pasifika Advanced Secondary School website. To enrol you will need to complete the enrolment forms and submit to the office of PASS.

- 1. Proof of identification (Passport or Birth Certificate)
- 2. Previous school report
- 3. Pastoral notes, Attendance records
- 4. Immunisation Certificate

Failure to bring all of this evidence in upon enrolment will delay your interview. If your child has a social worker or is involved with any family support workers e.g Oranga Tamariki, Genesis youth trust, Strive etc. a representative from the support group will need to be present at the appointed interview along with parent/caregiver and student. Complete the enrolment forms and scan to <u>office@pass.school.nz</u> or drop it off to PASS with all necessary documents.
