- If you come into the school grounds, you need to be fully masked and scan in or sign the register at the office entrance way.
- If your child has a school device and attending school, they need to bring it back for their learning at school.
- If your child is unwell, please notify the office immediately.

## **Attendance**

Today we had a 113 students at school, with a few notified absences. These students are now known as the 'OIS Bubble' for Alert Level 3 Step 2.

As stated in yesterday's COVID-19 Re-opening newsletter, the children attending today are expected to attend every day until the end of the year. We want to keep this 'OIS Bubble' safe and secure.

If your child did not return today and you want them to attend school, you will need to contact the school and have a discussion with a member of the Leadership Team. As mentioned above, we want to keep the 'OIS Bubble' safe. We do not want to burst our bubble.

## **Student Absences**

If your child is unwell, they must stay home.

During Alert Level 3 Step 2 we are requesting that parents/caregivers provide us with a medical certificate stating that their child is fit to return to school.

Once again, this is about ensuring that everyone in the 'OIS Bubble' is kept safe.

NOTE: If a child returns without a medical certificate, they will be sent home.
