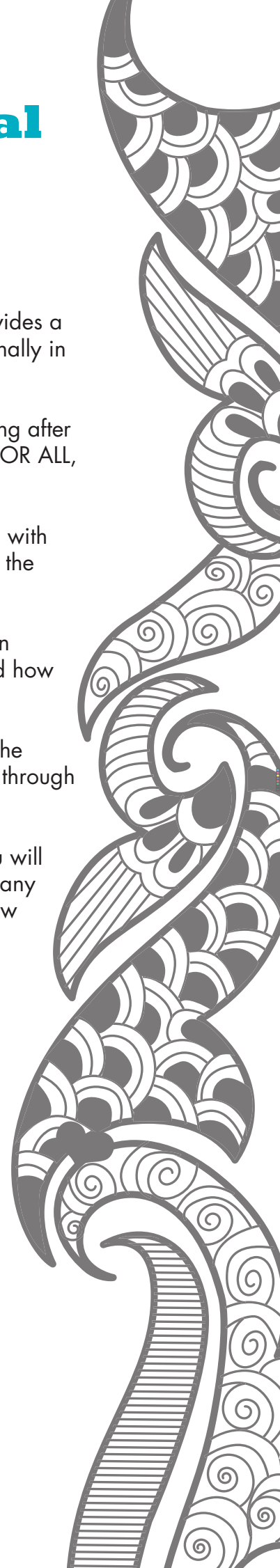

UNIFORMS

STUDENT SUPPORT

- Social Worker provided by ATWC – based at school
- Counsellors provided by Laidlaw and MIT – based part time at school
- RTLB – to support students' learning and behavior
- Police Education Officer – to provide ongoing support and mentoring programmes
- Public Health Nurse – to support health needs of students

We provide a range of additional support programmes to meet individual or group needs within our school, for example: Dress for Confidence, Reins, Police Mentoring and Tranzformers Programme
