#### Language Week Celebrations

This week is the last of the Pacific Language Celebration Weeks, as we celebrate Tokelau Language Week, which started on Sunday 23 October and finishes on Saturday 29 October. Tokelauan Language Week - Te Vaiaho o te Gagana Tokelau celebrates the culture and language of the more than 8,676 people of Tokelauan heritage who live in New Zealand.

Along with this Pacific celebration, we have also been acknowledging Diwali, also known as the "Festival of Lights," is recognized as India's biggest holiday and takes place over the course of five days. The festival occurs annually each autumn, often falling in either October or November depending on the moon. Diwali is celebrated primarily by Hindus but has become a national festival over the centuries.
